

Introducing the Phoebe Table

I would like to introduce you to the Phoebe Table. The image below shows the Phoebe Table with a Chair and Dresser, also of my design and built by Saturn Design. This was the layout for a furniture show booth. The Items had to fit within a 10' X 10' space. The configurability of the Phoebe Table made that an easy challenge to solve.



The essence of this table is its infinite shape configurability. Below are some of the forms it can take.






All these table forms and so many more are made from some combination of the three elements of the Phoebe Table pictured below: The (24)Crescent Leaves, the (30)Legs, and the Terminus.



The mathematical formula for the Phoebe Table is shown in the equation below.



For the non-mathematically inclined, this equation shows there are infinite possibilities in the form and use of the Phoebe Table.
